Savory cakes: When people eat cake, it's usually a sweet treat that incorporates such flavors as chocolate and vanilla. That's not the case with the creations at Tot Aw, a bakery in Jakarta, Indonesia. Short for "totally awesome," Tot Aw's bakers make cakes out of instant noodles.
