Savory cakes: When people eat cake, it's usually a sweet treat that incorporates such flavors as chocolate and vanilla. That's not the case with the creations at Tot Aw, a bakery in Jakarta, Indonesia. Short for "totally awesome," Tot Aw's bakers make cakes out of instant noodles. They press the cooked noodles into round forms and stack them into tiers. Each tier then gets "iced" with savory, rather than sweet, toppings, such as meatballs or curry chicken stew. These noodle cakes have become very popular, with people ordering them for birthdays and weddings.


